Lyrics can be recorded in your music library as metadata, just like the title of the song, artist, album, and genre information. However, not all songs in the library are likely to include lyrical information. For example, if you've extracted tracks from audio CDs using iTunes (now called Music), then you'll probably need to add text to metadata information. You can do this with the built-in iTunes editor or a special tag editing program. Media players like iTunes often don't have a solution for auto-tagging lyrical data outside the box. To add this functionality, you must use third-party software or download a song plugin. Alternatively, use music's built-in metadata editor and find words for your favorite songs using lyrics sites. These databases can often be searched to find specific songs. Lyrics can be copied from your browser screen and pasted into the metadata box for music lyrics. You'll probably need to consult a song lyrics database. Popular sites with thousands of songs that can be searched lyrics include Metro Lyric, Songlyrics, A-Z Lyrics Universe, and others. You can also search the web for a specific song followed by the word text. Follow these steps to manually add text to songs in the music library. Open iTunes (or the Music app) on your macOS and go to your music library. Select a song and open the song information. You can open the information window by right-clicking the song and selecting Get Info or selecting Song > Info... from the menu bar. Select the Text tab. If the selected song currently has no text, you'll see an empty window with no lyrics. Select the Custom text text check box. The empty window will become a text box. Switch to your web browser and go to the song lyrics database or resource of your choice. Copy the lyrics to the Clipboard. Highlight the lyrics by clicking and dragging the cursor over the text, and then copying it to the Clipboard. To copy the text, right-click the highlighted text and select Copy or select Edit > Copy from the menu bar. Use a keyboard shortcut to copy text:On a computer, hold down CTRL and press C.On Mac, hold down Command and press C. Go back to the Music app, and paste the copied text into the text text text text box. Right-click anywhere in the text box and select Paste or select Edit > Paste from the menu bar. Use a keyboard shortcut to paste text. On a computer, hold down CTRL and press V.On Mac, hold down Command and press V. Click OK to update the lyrics metadata. Next time you sync your iPod, iPhone, or iPad, you'll be able to follow the words on the screen without having to go down!
